



Officer Wins Guidance

We want to celebrate the great work our Sabbatical Officers and Part-Time Officers are doing and showcase the difference you're making for students. Wins help us recognise the impact of your work, share your achievements with staff and students, and celebrate the work happening across the Students' Union. Wins may be shared through our social media, newsletters and other communications. They can also help us recognise and celebrate Officers throughout the year.

What counts as a win?

A win can be anything where you, your Part-Time Officer or another Officer has made a positive difference for students. It doesn't have to be a huge change or a major campaign. The everyday work you do to represent students, raise issues and improve their experience is just as important.

Here are some examples of things you could submit:

Making change for students

- Achieving a change or improvement for students
- Working with University or Union staff to resolve an issue
- Helping to improve a course, module or wider student experience
- Raising an issue and helping to get it resolved
- Influencing a university decision or policy

Listening to students

- Gathering feedback from students
- Using student feedback to influence change
- Making sure student voices are heard in meetings or discussions

Campaigns and projects

- Successfully running a campaign or project
- Organising an event or initiative for students
- Getting students involved in an important issue
- Collaborating with other Officers, Reps, societies, staff or external organisations

Building community

- Creating opportunities for students to connect
- Improving the sense of community
- Working with societies or University staff to bring students together
- Supporting students to feel more connected to their university experience

Smaller wins matter too!

Don't feel like you need to wait until you've achieved something massive before submitting a win. It could be something as simple as successfully getting an issue raised with the right person, helping a student navigate a problem, getting a positive change agreed, or bringing students together.

If it made a difference to students, we want to hear about it!

Who can submit a win?

Sabbatical Officers and Part-Time Officers can submit wins about:

- Their own work
- Another Officer's work
- A project or campaign they have worked on
- Work they have done together with other Officers or Reps

You can also encourage the Reps you work with to submit their own wins!

What happens after you submit a win?

Submitted wins are reviewed by the Voice team and may be used to

- Celebrate Officers and Reps across Union communications
- Share achievements through social media and newsletters
- Showcase the impact of student representation
- Recognise outstanding work throughout the year
