

Hiring a Venue

We have four spaces within the Union which are bookable for events for clubs and societies. Remember all profits from bar spend goes back into making your student experience better. Additionally, all ticket money goes back to the club / soc and will be transferred to their own funds after the event. Our venues are FREE to hire as long as you meet the minimum bar tab:

Making a Booking

- Your event tickets can only be sold via www.tixtu.com
- You will have limited 'non-student' tickets just like all union events.
- Remember any guests attending the venue are a reflection of you and your event and they are your responsibility. If they cause trouble you could get barred from running future events and face disciplinary action, so everyone on their best behaviour please!

To make a booking please use the following form:

It would also be useful to have this information ready ahead of making your application:

- o Name of event
- o Date
- o Time
- o Venue
- o Short Description (one line)
- o Long Description (full event description)
- o Most importantly please ensure your event image is 450 x 300 pixels in size

Ticket Price(s) and how many of each:

- o Super Advance
- o Advance
- o Non-Students

Any money that you make through ticket sales will be transferred to your society/club own funds after the event, minus any costs you may have incurred.

Cancellation

If you cancel your event with less than one working days notice you are liable to pay the full bar deposit. If you cancel with less than five working days you are liable to pay £50. If you cancel before five working days there will be no charge.



Hiring a venue for events which do not require the bar being open are free, depending on the nature of the event and how many people will be attending and the finish times. Events will be considered on a case to case basis, but security and / or a Duty Manager may be required. You can also use any of the spaces for rehearsals, meetings etc. Contact Box Office to book a venue – ussu.boxoffice@surrey.ac.uk





Frequently Asked Questions

Who can hire Rubix or the Basement?

Any society or club. Only a signatory can make the booking, but they must be aware that they are booking it on behalf of the whole club or society. You can hire the Basement independently. If you hire the Basement as an individual student and not through a club or society you will be personally responsible for the costs and will be asked to pay a deposit. You cannot hire Rubix as an individual for personal gain.

Do we have to clean the venues when we finish?

Although you don't have to do any cleaning, if you put up any decorations, balloons, banners, etc, then you will be expected to remove them at the end of the night. The dressing room must be left how it was found.

Posters & Stickers

Posters must only be stuck to the wall with blue tack. Stickers must not be stuck anywhere; there will be a £5 removal charge per poster stuck with tape or sticker.

I want to use the DJ Booth in The Basement

Please ensure that the DJ booth is left tidy and clear of rubbish. If the DJ booth is left in a mess at the end of your event, you will be liable for a £30 cleaning fee, which will be deducted from your ticket sales. If the DJ booth is not clean and tidy before you start, please speak to the Duty Manager.

How do I use Haze in The Basement?

If you wish to use haze in your event. Please speak to the Duty Manager first. <u>Do not turn on the haze machine.</u>

Can we sell food?

If you want to use an outside catering company you must let us know beforehand and we must receive and approve all necessary documentation from the company.

Is there a Green Room?

The Green Room backstage in Rubix is free to use, however it must left as it is found. If it is left untidy you will be charged £25 cleaning costs. In addition, if any equipment or the Green Room is broken through misuse, you may also be charged for repair or replacement of the damaged item (including staff costs).

Can we have drinks promotions?

It is possible to organise drinks promotions through us.

We wish to do the event on behalf of a charity?

It is possible to give money to charity; however this must be directed through the RAG (Raising and Giving) committee. Contact <u>ussu.rag@surrey.ac.uk</u>

What if I don't want to do a club night with a bar?

It is possible to use the venue for non-club nights e.g. fashion shows, games nights, dance shows etc. We would usually require these events to finish around 23:00 and if there is no bar open tariffs will not apply. However sometimes there may be an additional cost for security / duty manager if they are deemed necessary.

Are there any tables and chairs in Rubix?

There are around 200 chairs in our furniture store or we have benches available which can be used free of charge. However you must get them out and put them away yourselves.
