Code of Conduct

All players, by taking part, also agree to adhere to the code of conduct. Please make sure to share this with all team members. The code of conduct also applies to all spectators.

Changing Facilities:

Due to the large number of fixtures taking place, the changing rooms at the Sports Centre will not be allocated to specific fixtures, instead one floor will be allocated to men and the second to women, with one room on each floor being allocated to Surrey, and the other to Royal Holloway competitors. There are also the changing rooms within the Sports Centre itself if anyone is not comfortable in using the main Pavilion ones.

Lost Property:

Lost property will be handed into the Sports Centre reception so any questions on the day can be directed there. The following day, we will be collecting the lost property and it will be available at the SU Helpdesk.

Scoring:

2 points for a win: 1 point for a draw: 0 points for a loss

Where a walkover is given – either from drop outs before the day, no shows, or if you are more than 25% late to your fixture, the points will be awarded to the opposing team.

Team Liaisons:

Every fixture or competition taking place should have a nominated team liaison.

For competitions taking place elsewhere on campus e.g. in the SU, Medicine, Jane Holloway or in a lecture theatre – please make sure to meet your counterparts from Surrey at The Hub and guide them to the right place.

The Event:

There will be food vendors in the main Fan Zone as well as a bar who will be serving non-alcoholic and alcoholic options from 11am. Alcohol purchased on site may be consumed in the designated areas, the Fan Zone and pitch side but must not be taken onto pitches.

RHUL and RHSU reserve the right to eject anyone who is behaving in such a way that is judged as being distressing to others and/or a threat to individual safety, breaching the code of conduct.

As well as food and drink, in the fan zone will be the RHUL & Surrey HQ where you can find a member of staff to ask questions. You will also find the Welfare Zone where you can pop by if you need a moment to sit down or get some support.

By the football pitches will be the Activity Zone where there will be a variety of different games and activities to take part in throughout the day including Inflatable dart football, pickle ball, spike ball and much more.

First Aid:

There will be medics on site, so if you or our team require any medical attention you will be able to find them based at the sports centre. If they're not already on your pitch, you can contact the fixtures phone in the key contacts section below or head to the Welfare Zone and a member of staff will be able to get in contact with the medics for you.

For any basic first aid materials such as ice packs or plasters, you can head to the Welfare Zone where we've got some available!

Please also inform us of any incidents or injuries that take place during your fixture via the fixtures phone.

Food and Drink:

There will be a bar and food vendors at the sports centre from 11am supplying alcoholic and nonalcoholic drinks and food from Naan & Sizzle & Bratwurst UK.

Around campus there is also:

- The Students' Union shop open from 8am, selling everything from sandwiches and crisps to fruit and drinks
 - Tommy's Kitchen serving a range of subs, wraps, dirty fries and drinks
 - Boilerhouse Café they sell sandwiches and pastries as well as hot drinks
 - Café on the Square in the library, selling sandwiches and hot drinks
 - Kimiko based in the Hub, serving hot Japanese dishes and fresh sushi
 - The Van Serving vegetarian burgers, soup and toasties. You'll find them by the Boilerhouse café
 - Crosslands serving hot meals from 12pm
