Surrey Decides Bye-Election

Our student election is called *SurreyDecides*, and is the largest democratic event of its kind, when all the Union Officers are elected by a vote that takes place at the beginning of Semester 2.

SurreyDecides is your opportunity to stand out from the crowd and become a student leader, no matter what stage you are in your studies or your previous experiences – any student can take part.

Following our election in February, we have two part-time positions available that we're looking to fill:

Societies Chair in the Activity Zone Community Zone Committee Member

We are recruiting for these roles through what is called a bye-election. It is similar to the larger election we hold in Semester 2, however it is scaled down a bit as there are only two roles.

Nominations were open from 21 - 25 October and we now have our candidates. As part of their nomination, they were invited to produce a manifesto, outlining their plans, if elected. You can read the manifestos submitted on the following pages.

On Wednesday 30 October at 18:30 we will hold our *Question Time* event on Teams, where you can hear from the candidates and pose your questions. Join the meeting here.

Finally, voting will open from 20:00 on 30 October – 17:00 on 1 November. **It is really important you vote** as it's your way of saying what you want to happen at Surrey. Once voting closes, we will announce the winners on Friday 1 November.

As a part of this, Chris wants to make sure that student groups feel heard and understand why decisions are made




COMMUNITY


