### Role Description:

This is an exciting opportunity to lead the Disability & Neurodiversity Subnetwork and work with the Student Equality Network to achieve its goals. The Subnetwork Leader role is integral to ensuring Disabled and Neurodiverse students' opinions are heard within the Union. This role is ideal for anyone looking for experience in leadership, project management, or EDI activity.

This is a temporary role in preparation for the Networks' full launch in September 2025, after which a new 1-year position will be advertised.

### Responsibilities of Role:

- To lead Subnetwork meetings to gather information and students' opinions, thoughts and ideas
- Lead the Subnetwork and act as the main point of contact for broader feedback which may need escalating to the Student Equality Network or Students' Union
- Collaborate with the Network leads on behalf of the Disability & Neurodiversity subnetwork to share their opinions, thoughts and ideas
- Collaborate with the Student Equality Network, VP Voice, and Union staff to plan and organise events and activities that align with student interests and goals
- Promote the Student Equality Network and the Disability & Neurodiversity Subnetwork to increase involvement, engagement and membership
- Work with your Subnetwork to create and contribute to the My Lived Experiences Project to share and promote diverse voices from the Disability & Neurodiversity subnetwork
