

## Community Members information

This is the membership available for **non-students** to join and participate in sessions at the University of Surrey Judo club. The cost of the membership contributes to the cost of running Surrey Sports Park Facilities and Coaching.

Sessions:

**Mondays** – 21:15 – 22:30

**Sundays** – 18:00 – 20:30

### How much does it cost?

The Team Surrey community membership costs **£120 per year**. This expires 30<sup>th</sup> September every year.

### Why get a community membership for Judo?

Buying the membership will allow non-students to attend **all judo training sessions**. Community members will also be covered by **Team Surrey Public Liability Insurance** and **Personal Injury insurance**. When grading and renewing their BJA license, community members will be able to use University of Surrey Judo Club as their designated club.

Currently, the University of Surrey Judo Club enters 2 judo competitions as club each year:

**Sheffield Uni Kyu Tournament (SUKT)** in November - Community members are able to compete in this as a member of the University of Surrey Judo Club

**British Universities & Colleges Sport (BUCS)** in February – Not available to community members due to rules stipulated by the competition body themselves

However, community members must self-fund their places and organise own transportation.

As a club, we do offer guidance on other competitions available to all members. Community members can use University of Surrey Judo Club as their designated club when entering any of these competitions.

### How to join?

To purchase the community membership, you will have to come **in-person to the Surrey Sports Park reception desk to pay**.

You will also need to provide your name and an email address to the University of Surrey Judo club, which will then be sent to Team Surrey for details so that the membership can be put into the system.
